Game Face Ohio and TSC Reach Exclusive Agreement

St. Marys Memorial and Wapakoneta high school games to be aired on TSC

WAPAKONETA, Ohio (GameFaceOhio.com) – Game Face Ohio has signed an agreement with Telephone Service Company (TSC) to produce video broadcasts of St. Marys Memorial High School and Wapakoneta High School athletic contests. The content produced by Game Face Ohio will be distributed exclusively on TSC’s cable television system as part of its local programming.

In total, over 30 games per school will be broadcast during the academic year.

TSC Chief Operating Officer Lonnie Pedersen said, "We are excited to begin this partnership with Game Face Ohio. This agreement allows our schools to reach significantly new audiences by showcasing coverage of their student athletes. Todd and his team at Game Face have the expertise and know-how to raise the level of local high school sports broadcasting to a new level."

Game Face Ohio utilizes state-of-the-art television production equipment, resulting in a network-style broadcast. Major networks, such as ABC, FOX Sports, ESPN, use the same equipment for various events. Users can expect four to six camera angles for each broadcast, as well as network-style graphics and instant-replay.

Each broadcast will be aired at 10:30pm on the day of the game on TSC channel 2. Additional replays of each game will be aired on subsequent days. The fall schedule will be released on www.telserco.com and www.gamefaceohio.com approximately August 1st.
